Maine Learning Results: Social Studies:A1, A2, A3

Key Concepts:

Activity: Draw on a long piece of butcher paper a picture of a highway. Explain that we as a class are going to keep track of our lessons learned and garden accomplishments on this road map, and as the year goes on it will be a record of everything that we have done in our garden and related to our garden. Designate a section of the road for each season, and periodically take time as a class to brainstorm things that we have done in the garden, related to the garden, and things that we have learned from the garden.

Materials: Long piece of butcher paper, markers, tape

Notes: This lesson is listed in the fall because it begins here, but it must be revisited periodically throughout the year.
